**Hallam Diocesan Pastoral Council.** "In each Diocese a pastoral council is to be established. Its function, under the authority of the bishop, is to study and weigh those matters which concern the pastoral works in the diocese, and to propose practical conclusions concerning them." Can 511 (Code of Canon Law 1983) "A pastoral council is composed of members of Christ's faithful who are in full communion with the Catholic Church: clerics, consecrated religious and especially lay people, chosen by the diocesan Bishop." Can 512 #1 "members assigned to the pastoral council must reflect all the People of God in the diocese." Can 512 #2 "Only those members of Christ's faithful who are outstanding in firm faith, high moral stands and prudence are to be assigned to the pastoral council." Can 512 #3 "Membership is for a limited period only determined by the bishop." Can 513 #1 **If you're interested in being considered for service as a member of this Pastoral Council, please contact Fr. Paul to arrange for a joint application form to be completed. DO NOT CONTACT THE BISHOP DIRECTLY – ALL NOMINATIONS MUST COME THROUGH YOUR PARISH PRIEST ONLY.**
